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5.2. Teaching experiences:

1. Title of the teaching course: European Neighbourhood Policy

2. Title of the teaching course: Institutions and functioning of the European Union

3. Title of the teaching course: Decision-making Process and Lobbying in the EU

Description: The course covers two components: theoretical and practical. The theoretical part analyses the UE institutions and their prerogatives as well as decision making processes in all the EU. The main part of the course concentrates on the role of lobbying in the EU decision-making process.
